



Institute on Doing Business and Law in China

Two alumni of the China Program have donated in honor of the 10th anniversary of the St. Mary's School of Law China Study Abroad Program. Because they believe every student should reap the benefits of international legal study with an opportunity for an internship in a Chinese law firm they have offered generous support to help access an international legal experience in China by defraying some of the associated costs.

Selection criteria includes demonstrating a reason for interest to study in China, commitment to learn about and share Chinese culture, advance the legal profession through the international outlook, financial need. Preference is given to married students in need of financial assistance or a student incurring additional expenses with participation in an internship.

Criteria and eligibility (China applicants):

- a. Applicant must be a St. Mary's Law student.
- b. Applicant must submit a resume.
- c. Demonstrate financial need.
- d. 1st Priority Choice for law student who has a traveling spouse.
- e. 2nd Priority Choice for law student who has an internship in China or additional family responsibilities.

General Instructions:

1. DEADLINE for scholarship applications is **March 20, 2019, 5:00 p.m.** (no exceptions).
2. You will be notified by email regarding the status of your application.
3. Award winners will be announced by April 2019.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form and resume.
2. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. Please include your name, email, address, class year, student ID and phone number on an attached coversheet.
3. Submit your essay and responses to the questions referenced in application. These questions must be at least 1-2 pages, typed, and double-spaced. Please ensure your questions contains no grammatical errors.
