

Pre-Application Checklist

The Special Education Advocacy Summit (SEAS) has specific criteria for accepting applicants into the program.

For your convenience, and to save you time and money, SEAS provides this pre-application checklist. You do not need to check all the boxes to be qualified for the program. Circumstances might call for an explanation. If that is the case, we encourage you to complete the application, which will allow you to explain why you could not check a box.

The application committee makes final acceptance decisions.

This checklist is for your use. You do not need to send the checklist to the application committee.

- A school district does not employ me or any of my immediate family members.
- A law firm representing school districts does not employ me or any of my immediate family members.
- I have at least two years of experience in special education advocacy outside of advocating for my child.
- I have never been disciplined by, reprimanded by, or reported to any state Bar association.
- I have never been arrested, charged, and/or convicted of any felony or misdemeanor (other than traffic offenses).
- I can arrive on-site in San Antonio, Texas, in time to attend the evening reception on Wednesday, June 5, 2024, and will depart after the end of the program on Saturday, June 8, 2024.
